ART BUILDING AND THEATER BUILDING RELOCATION PARKING OPTIONS FOR STUDENTS, FACULTY AND STAFF FAQ December 13th, 2011

1) What CSU parking will be available to me if I have a prepaid CSU Parking hangtag and work or take classes in the Middough Building?

A: Your CSU Prepaid parking hangtag will provide access to all currently designated CSU Prepaid parking facilities, including South Garage (SG) and West Garage (WG). We know that there is a high demand for the spaces in WG, but SG (a 5 -10 minute walk from the Middough Building) typically has plenty of space available throughout the day and Prepaid hangtag holders may access SG with a valid Viking Card.

In addition, the RTA E-Line Trolley runs from the Stephanie Tubbs Jones Transit Center (adjacent to SG) to E. 13th and Euclid every 10 minutes from 7am to 7pm on weekdays and is **free** for all riders. Students may also elect to use their UPass on the Healthline and get off at the E. 13th and Euclid stop.

Finally, the University is in discussions with AMPCO Parking to lease the thirty (30) spaces located on the surface lot at 16th and Euclid that would be designated as parking for Middough tenants only. We will keep everyone updated as details on this agreement are worked out.

2) These choices don't work for me. What else can I do?

A: There are several parking facilities located very close to the Middough Building that are operated by private parking companies. For Faculty and Staff, if you find that you are not able to use a CSU Prepaid parking hangtag and wish to use a private parking facility instead, you simply need to return your Prepaid hangtag to the Parking & Transportation Services Office (at E. 24th and Euclid – across from Fenn Tower) and you will get a prorated refund or your automatic payroll deduction will be cancelled as applicable.

Students who have purchased a spring semester Prepaid hangtag and find they are unable to use CSU Prepaid parking facilities may return the hangtag and receive a prorated refund.

3) I have a disabled parking placard and need parking close to the building. What are my options?

A: The University has secured the rights to five (5) spaces in the parking facility located on the first floor of the Middough Building. The remaining onsite parking is reserved for exclusive use by Middough Inc. These spaces are designated for CSU Prepaid hangtag holders who have a disabled parking placard. A special hangtag will be issued to individuals who need to use these spaces by CSU Parking & Transportation Services.

However, the parking facility is managed by AMPCO who will be responsible for enforcing parking rules in that location.

4) I often have evening classes. What about safety and security in that area?

A: The CSU Police Department has extended its coverage area to include service to the Middough Building and a call to 216-687-2020 is all that's needed to have a University Safety Escort dispatched to your location to escort you to your car any time of the day or night. In addition, the University has installed "blue-light" emergency stations in two locations outside the building and on the floors occupied by CSU.
