VISUAL ART MERIT SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION
2012-2013

Approximately \$40,000 in scholarship, up to full tuition, is awarded on the basis of artistic merit.

ELIGIBILITY: Current and prospective full-time undergraduate **art majors** seeking a first B.A. degree and needing at least 24 additional credit hours for graduation who have not defaulted on a previous CSU Merit Scholarship agreement within the past year.

CONDITIONS: All scholarship recipients must . . .

- enroll full-time (minimum of 12 credit hours per semester) at Cleveland State University
- enroll in at least one ART course per semester
- declare Art as a major when applying and also during the scholarship period
- have and maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average (GPA) overall, and a minimum 3.0 GPA for ART courses
- participate fully in the Student Organization of Fine Art (SOFA) or student chapter of the American Institute of Graphic Arts (AIGA)
- present work that was created during the scholarship period in one of two public exhibition/presentation opportunities in the Spring

HOW TO APPLY: Submit **ONLY** the following materials in a 10" x 13" envelope (anything additional will not be viewed):

- Completed application form (see other side — copies are acceptable)
- Six (6) images of work created within the last 12 months. Submit one CD with JPEG images at 72 dpi (minimum recommended size 500 x 500 pixels). Label each image file with a number (1 – 6)_your last name_ and first initial. For example: 1_Smith_B.jpg 2_Smith_B.jpg etc. *See helpful hints below.*
- On a separate sheet list your name, title of work (with corresponding image file number), date completed, medium, and dimensions in inches (Height x Width x Depth)
- Recommended, but not required: A brief statement about your work and artistic objectives

HINTS ON PREPARING YOUR IMAGES:

Include individual .jpg files only. Do not use presentation formats (e.g. PowerPoint). No DVDs.

Test your CD on a computer other than your own (preferably on both a Mac and a PC) to ensure your disc is readable. Unreadable discs will make your application incomplete.

Follow formatting and labeling instructions carefully.

Previously submitted work, original art objects, unsolicited items, and incomplete applications will NOT be considered.

Provide a self-addressed stamped envelope for the return of materials, or pick up by April 27, 2012. Unclaimed materials will be discarded.

ADMINISTRATION: One half of the scholarship award is applied to Fall Semester tuition. Students must pass a scholarship review and consult with a Merit Scholarship Advisor before registering for Spring Semester to receive the second half of the award.
